A Few Important Points

2. GPS works fine in urban areas but not so well in rural ones. Vermont does not have universal cell coverage. When in doubt, use our directions.

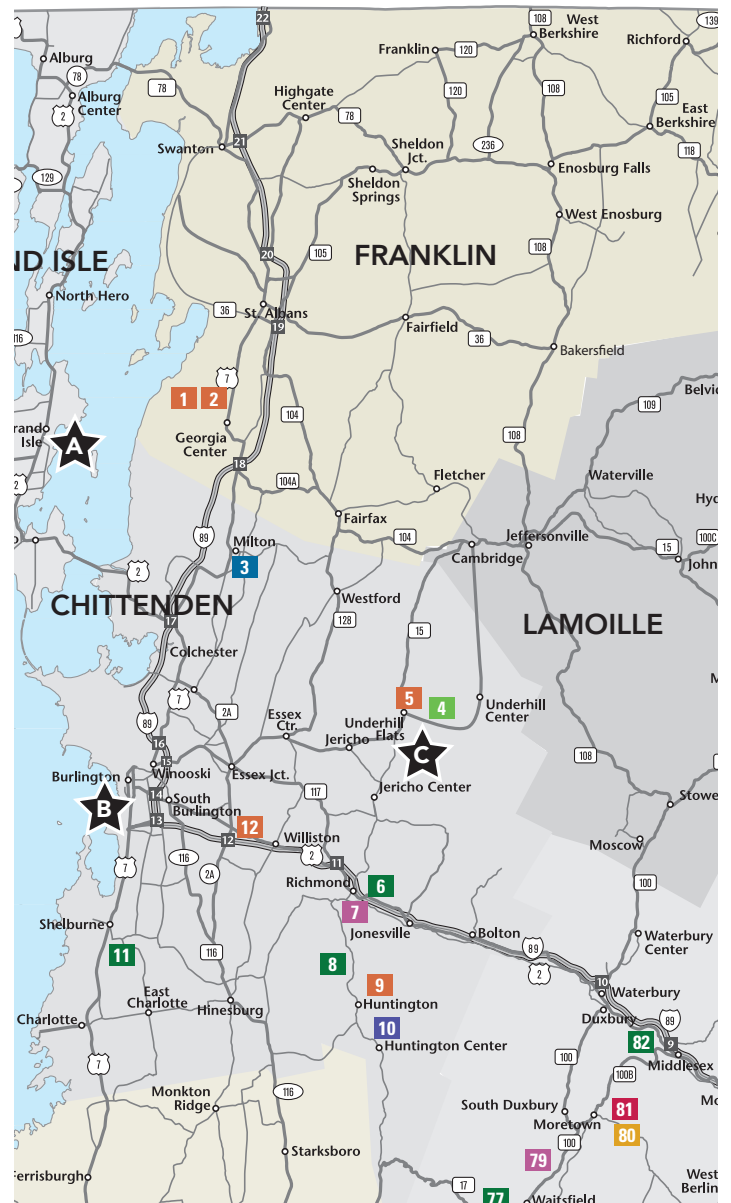

1. Claire Payne Studios - Claire Payne. Painting, sculpture, fine art studio. 4787 Ethan Allen Highway, St. Albans VT 05478. (802) 782-5930. From I-89 take exit 18 - Georgia Center. Turn north onto Rte 7, drive 3 miles to the Georgia Elementary School and continue 0.25 mile north. Find my studio on the left side of the road.

2. The Art of Mylissa Kowalski - Mylissa Kowalski Davis. Landscape and wildlife paintings in oil. 1163 Buck Hollow Rd, Fairfax VT 05454. (425) 698-5324. Mylissa will show at Claire Payne's studio at 4787 Ethan Allen Highway, St. Albans VT 05478. See directions in that listing.

3. Milton Artists Guild. Work by more than 100 artists. 199 Route 7, Hannaford Plaza, Milton VT 05468. (802) 355-6583. From I-89N, take exit 17, head north on Rte 7 towards the center of Milton. We are located in the strip mall behind the Milton Post Office and right next to Aubuchon Hardware.

4. Gerald K. Stoner - Gerry Stoner. Whimsical, graceful, welded steel sculpture. 185 River Rd, Underhill VT 05489. (802) 324-3897. From Jolley's Store on Rte 15 in Jericho, travel toward River Rd. Take the first right onto River Rd and drive 1.9 miles. Find us in the blue farmhouse with red doors at 185 River Rd.

5. Sweet Enemy Art - Kristin Richland. Imaginative paintings, prints, and spirited creatures. 52 Maple Ridge Rd, Underhill VT 05489. (802) 899-2621. From Rte 15 turn right at Jolley's store onto River Road. Just after the cemetery on the corner of River Rd and Park St, make a quick left onto Maple Ridge Rd. Travel for 0.5 mile, #52 is on the right immediately after the green water tower.

6. Meinhardt Design Inc - Jean Meinhardt. Hand-thrown porcelain pottery, micro-crystalline glazes. 202 Murray Drive, Richmond VT 05477. (802) 434-2409. From exit 11 on I-89, turn onto Rte 2 and travel east toward Richmond. Continue straight through the traffic light in Richmond and go about 3 miles. Look for a red barn on the right. Murray Drive is opposite the barn. Turn left onto Murray Drive and go to the top. Traveling west on Rte 2 from Waterbury, go 0.5 mile past Jonesville and see the red barn on the left, Murray Drive on the right. Go to the top of the drive.

7. Radiate Art Space - Heather Drury. Community space for local artists. 203 Bridge St, Richmond VT 05477. (802) 238-4906. From exit 11 on I-89, take Rte 2 east to the stoplight in the center of Richmond. Turn right onto Bridge Street. We are in the lower level of the Town Center, a brick building in front of Post Office on left.

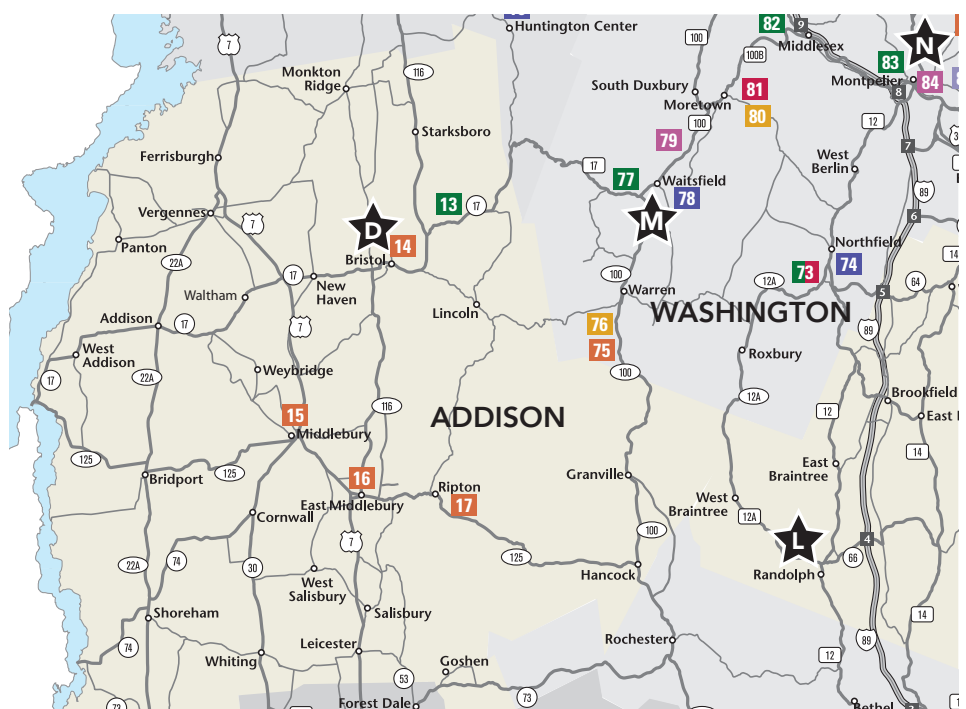
8. Gordon Rowe. Ceramics both thrown and handbuilt. 239 Texas Hill Rd, Huntington VT 05462. (802) 881-3975. From Richmond, take the Huntington Rd about 6 miles to Texas Hill Road. Turn right on Texas Hill Rd, and the studio is up 0.33 mile on the left.

9. Daryl V. Artworks - Daryl Storrs. Landscapes, jewelry, woodcuts, pastels, color. 235 Bridge St, Huntington VT 05462. (802) 434-5040. From I-89 north or south, take Richmond exit 11. Go south on Rte 2 towards Richmond. At traffic light take a right onto Bridge Street. Go over RR tracks, river, and by Round Church (on the left). Bear right around corner. Go about 6.5 miles to Huntington. Pass Beauty's Store and turn left onto Bridge St and cross the bridge. My house is the third on the left with the studio in the red barn next to the house.

10. Kevin Jenness Woodworking - Kevin Jenness. Elegant, functional furniture, boxes and bowls. 700 East St, Huntington VT 05462. (802) 434-3438. From Richmond, go 7 miles south to Huntington. Pass the village green, and go slightly left onto East St (Main St continues to the right) and follow East St for 0.7 miles to the first place on the right after the pavement ends. This will be a cedar shingled house and shop.

11. Vermont Clay Guild - Barbara Murphy. Clay forms and functional clay ware. 45 Mount Philo Rd, Shelburne VT 05482. (802) 985-1202. The house is located at the beginning of Mount Philo Rd in Shelburne Village. We are in the second house south of the intersection of Falls, Marsett and Mt Philo Rds.

12. Kimberlee Forney. Many colorful original paintings and prints. 4518 Williston Road, Williston VT 05495. (802) 310-9159. From Exit 14, Interstate 89, South Burlington, head east on Williston Rd./US 2 for about 3 miles. Look for yellow Open Studio signs.

14. Deborah Holmes Watercolors - Deborah Holmes. Watercolors, giclee prints and acrylagouache paintings. 24 Garfield St, Bristol VT 05443. (802) 453-8511. From the center of Bristol, turn north on North St, turn right on Garfield St at Almost Home. We are the fourth house on the left. Traveling south on Rte 116, turn onto North St. Turn left onto Garfield St, still the fourth house on the left.

15. Trillium Art & Beyond - Yinglei Zhang. Chinese painting and calligraphy, ceramic, stone and woodwork. 56 High St, Middlebury VT 05753. (802) 388-8229. High St is the street behind Swift House Inn. From Rte 7S, pass Methodist Church on your right, turn right at traffic light onto Stewart Lane. From Rte 7 N, turn left at traffic light onto Stewart Lane, turn left onto High St and travel to the end. Look for yellow Open Studio signs.

16. Mike Mayone Fine Art - Mike Mayone. Paintings, prints, note cards, realism, lessons. 8 Case St, Middlebury VT 05753. (802) 388-7401. From Middlebury, go south on Rte 7 about 3+ miles, then left onto Rte 125 east towards East Middlebury for 0.5 mile. At the 4 way stop, go left between the post office and convenience store onto Rte 116N (Case St), a few houses up on the right, a single story (8 Case St). Studio is upstairs in the blue garage in back. From the central VT/ Rte 100 area, take Rte 125 in Hancock and go west over the mountain (about 15.5 scenic miles) to the intersection with Rte 116. Go right and follow above directions.

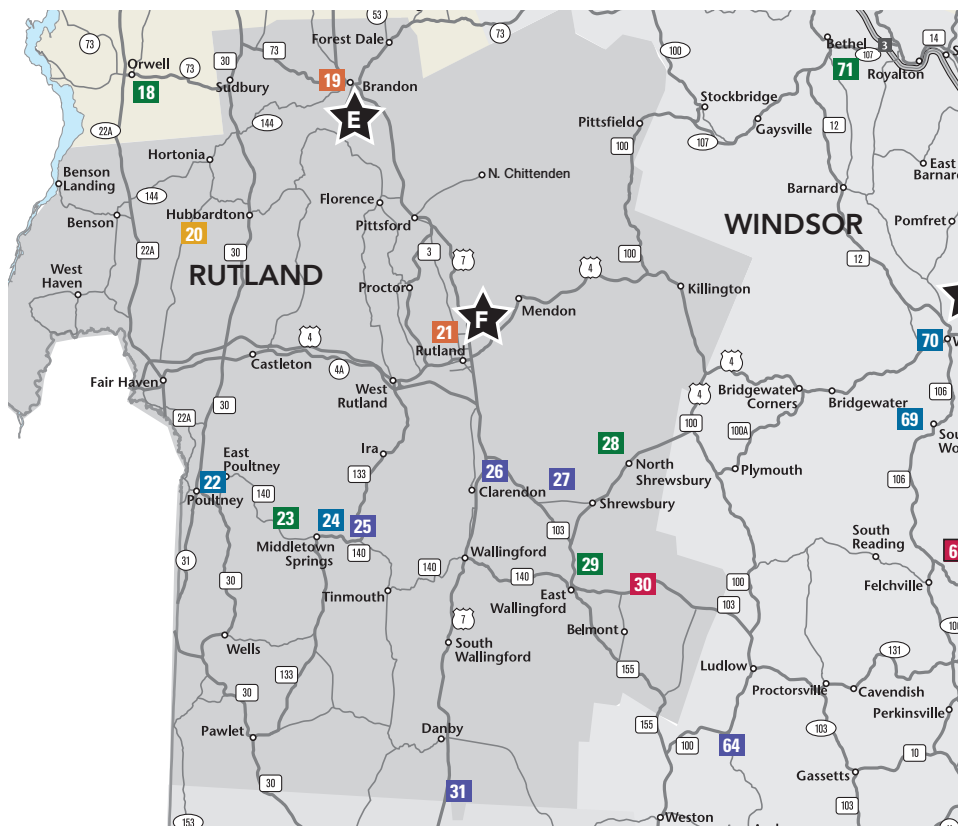

Studio is on Rte 125, one building east of the Ripton store, in the Old Blacksmith Shop, on the south side of the street. Park in front or beside the building, or in the driveway at the blue house with yellow trim next door or in the Chipman Inn parking lot across the street.

18. Mud Puppy Pottery - Andy Snyder. Pottery demonstrations, exhibits and sales. 2386 Sunset Lake Rd, Orwell VT 05760. (802) 793-4728. Take Rte 22A, (south from Vergennes or north from Fair Haven) and travel to its intersection with Rte 144 in Benson also called the Benson Rd. Travel to Sunset Lake Rd, about 1.7 miles and turn left. Travel for about 2.5 miles. My studio is the first place on the right after Camp Sunrise.

19. Joan Drew - Original watercolor paintings. 29 Union St, Brandon VT 05733. (802) 236-8470. In Brandon, turn left onto Union St and travel to the building just over the railroad tracks. Located on the right about 2 blocks from Rte 7.

20. Karen Deets Stained Glass - Karen Deets. Stained glass, painted, fused, panels. 728 Moscow Rd, Fair Haven VT 05743. (802) 265-8668. From the Rutland area, take Rte 4W to exit 3 (Fair Haven). Turn right onto Scotch Hill Rd. Continue about 4.5 miles to Glen Lake and then make a left onto Moscow Rd. We are situated on the right 0.7 mile up the road.

21. Sally Jenne Keefe - Original drawings, prints, cards. 52 Kingsley Ave, Rutland VT 05701. (802) 773-3042. In Rutland, at the junction of Rtes 4 and 7, travel to the third left, Roberts Ave and turn left. Turn right at next intersection (Roberts Ave. and Lincoln Ave). Turn left at the next street, Kingsley Ave. I am the next to last house on the left.

22. Stone Valley Arts at Fox Hill - Terry Hauptman, Jeanne and Hugh Joudry.

145 East Main St, Poultney VT 05764. (802) 884-8052. Located one eighth mile east from the intersection of Rte 30 and Main St (Rte 140), directly across from the Poultney High School.

23. Rising Meadow Pottery - Diane Rosenmiller and Nicholas Seidner. Utilitarian stoneware and porcelain pottery. 50 West St, Middletown Springs VT 05757. (802) 235-9429. In the town of Middletown Springs, from the intersection of Rtes 140 and 133, take Rte 140 (West St) 0.2 mile to the fifth driveway on the right side of the road. Look for our sign.

24. Sissy's Kitchen - Paintings, photography, pottery, furniture and jewelry. 10 West St, Middletown Springs VT 05757. (802) 235-2000. In the town of Middletown Springs, from the 4 corners intersection of Rtes 140 and 133, take Rte 140 (West St) 0.1 mile to the second driveway on the right side of the road heading west.

25. David Munyak, Wood Turner - David Munyak. Handmade bowls, woodturning, treenware. PO Box 1181, 99 East St., Middletown Springs VT 05757. (802) 235-1390. From the junction of Rte 133 and Rte 140, travel east on East St. for 0.3 miles. #99 will be on the left side of the road.

26. G Felder... Hand Carved Bowls - Gene Felder. Traditionally made handcarved bowls. 149 Adams Rd, Shrewsbury VT 05738.

(802) 558-9068. In Shrewsbury, from Rte 103, turn onto Lincoln Hill Rd. Adams Rd is the first left. Bear left at the fork and we are the 2nd drive on left.

27. Nature's Turn, LLC - Gerry Martin.

Woodturned bowls and vessels. 998 Lincoln Hill Rd, Shrewsbury VT 05738. (802) 492-2244. From Rte 7, drive 3 miles south of Rutland to the junction with Rte 103. Turn on Rte 103 and travel southeast for 2.8 miles and turn left on Lincoln Hill Rd. Continue 1 mile over crest of hill and turn right on to private drive for 996 and 998 Lincoln Hill Rd. Shop is 0.25 mile straight ahead.

28. Maya Zelkin Pottery - Maya Zelkin.

Functional, woodfired, stoneware and porcelain pottery. 116 Coldham Rd, Shrewsbury VT 05738. (802) 492-2045. From Rte 103 in Cuttingsville, turn onto Town Hill Rd. Travel 1.8 miles to intersection with Lincoln Hill Rd and turn right. Go 3.9 miles to Cold River Road and turn left. Travel 0.2 mile to Upper Cold River Rd and turn right. Travel one mile to Coldham Rd, and turn right. The studio is at the second driveway on the right. From Rte 7 south of Rutland, turn onto North Shrewsbury Rd. Travel one mile to Cold River Rd and turn right. Travel 7 miles to Upper Cold River Rd and turn left. Go one mile to Coldham Rd and turn right. Studio is at the second driveway on the right.

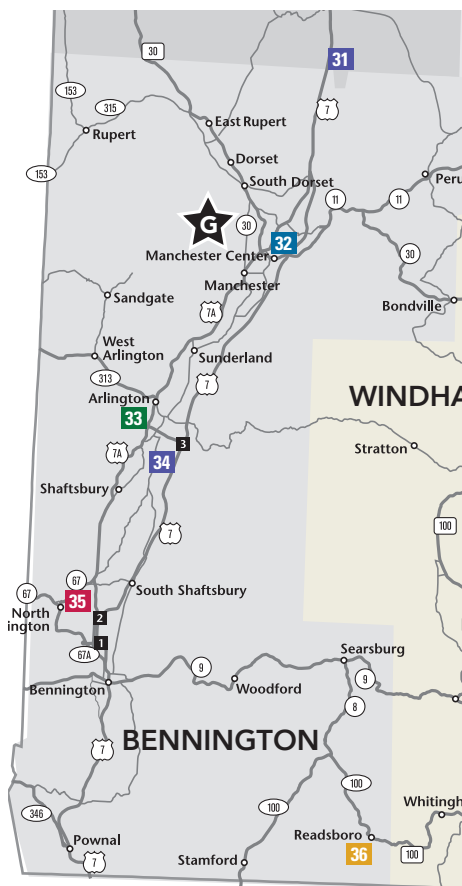

We are directly across from the entrance to Old Turnpike Rd in East Wallingford. From the south travel north on Rte 103. When entering Mount Holly, look for the junction with Rte 140 and continue north for 1.8 miles. We are on the left side directly across from the entrance to Old Turnpike Rd in East Wallingford. The studio is grey with green trim.

Continue on this highway, with the city of Montpelier and the river on your left, until you come to a traffic circle. Take the second exit onto Rte 2, and travel 0.3 mile to Gallison Hill Rd. Turn left at the Kia sign onto Gallison Hill Rd and go 0.8 mile to the studio on the left in a gray house with blue trim, #846.

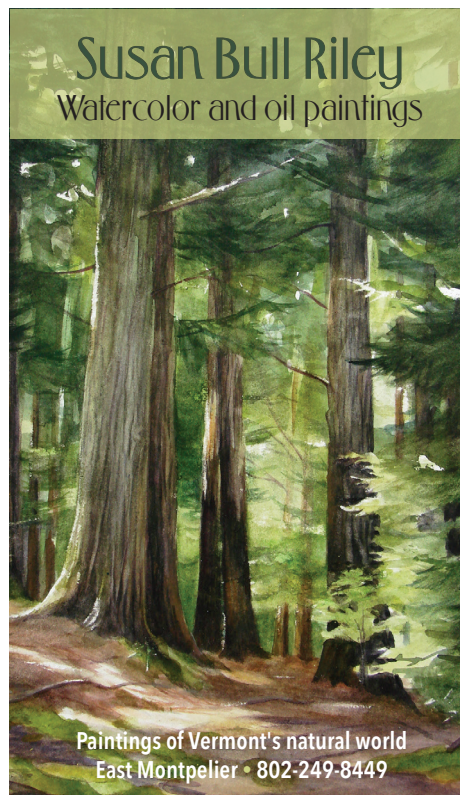
86. Susan Bull Riley. Classical paintings, oils and watercolors, of botanicals, birds, and landscapes. 1550 Center Rd, E Montpelier VT 05602. (802) 249-8449. On I-89, take exit 8, Montpelier, and travel through three traffic lights to the intersection at a stoplight with Rte 12. Turn left onto Rte 12, Main St. Follow Main St through a traffic light at to a roundabout. Take the first exit off the roundabout and continue on Main St up the hill. From the roundabout go 1.6 miles to Center Rd, just past a cemetery. Turn gentle right onto Center Rd and go 1.5 miles on Center Rd to our red house on the right, a former one room schoolhouse. Park in the circular driveway.

87. Blackthorne Forge - Steven C. Bronstein. Functional and sculptural, contemporary ironwork. 3821 Rte 2, Marshfield VT 05658. (802) 426-3369. We are 2 miles west of Marshfield on Rte 2 in the large yellow barn on the left, or 6 miles east of Plainfield on Rte 2 on the right.

88. Bent Nails Studios - Aaron Scot Ingham. Unique, provocative, functional work using mostly repurposed materials. 1292 Rte 2, Marshfield VT 05658. (802) 563-4148. On Rte 2 in Marshfield Village, next to the cemetery and across from the fire station.

89. Cabot Artisans Gallery. Art, unique local Vermont products. 3053 Main St, Cabot VT 05647. (802) 563-2064. Take Rte 2 to Marshfield, turn left onto Rte 215 and travel toward Cabot Creamery. Continue past the Creamery 100 yards to the village center. We are located at 3053 Main St.

90. Sandy Pond Studios - Sandy Pond. Colorfully diverse, functional, sculptural pottery. 3087 Main St, Cabot VT 05647. (802) 917-8883. Located in "Downtown Cabot" on Main St above Harry's Hardware a few steps from the Cabot Artisans Gallery.

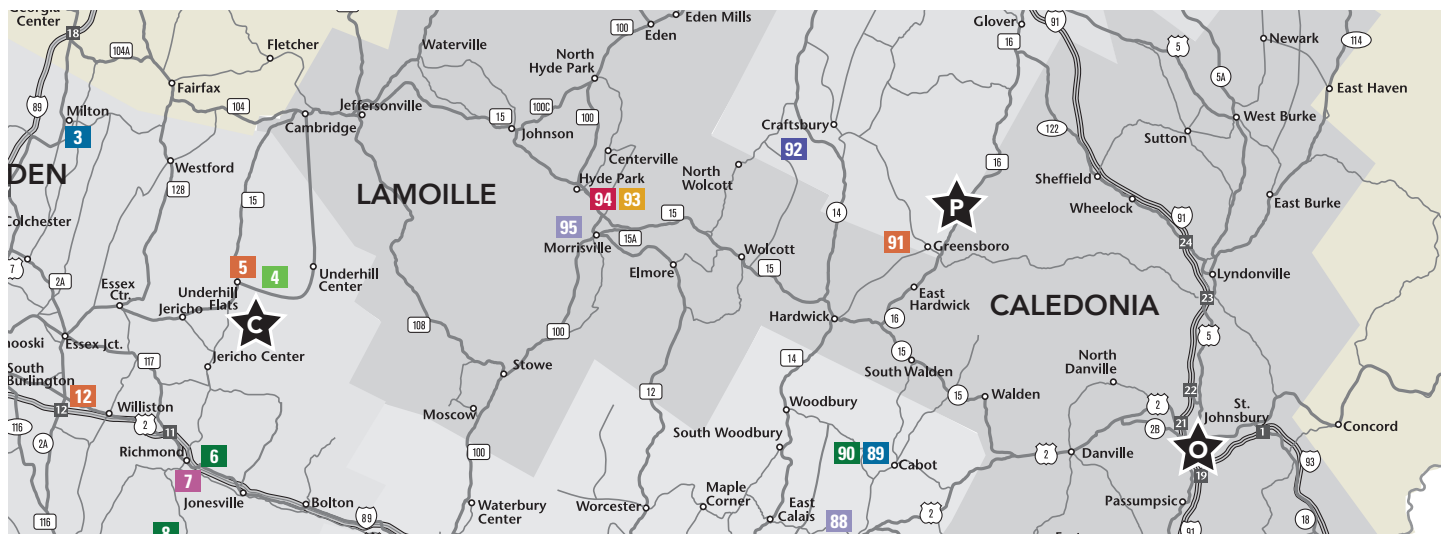
